

**WHAT ARE THE FOUR COMPONENTS OF A FAIR CHALLENGE?**

1. Shoulder to Shoulder.
2. Within playing distance of the ball.
3. One foot on the ground.
4. Not done with excessive force.

**NAME THE FOUR "P'S" TO APPLY ADVANTAGE.**

1. Possession of the ball by team or player.
2. Potential for attack, ability to continue a dangerous scoring attack.
3. Personnel - skill of attacking players/team.
4. Proximity - Closeness to the goal.

**WHAT ARE THE FOUR "D'S" IN ORDER FOR A PLAYER TO BE SENT OFF FOR DENYING AN OBVIOUS GOAL SCORING OPPORTUNITY?**

1. Defenders - Not more than 1 between foul and goal, not counting the defender who fouled.
2. Distance to goal - closer to goal less chance to score.
3. Distance to ball - Attacker must be close enough to play the ball.
4. Direction of play - Play towards the goal.
